

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY OF MESQUITE CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL POLICE LIEUTENANT AND INCREASING THE NUMBER OF FIRE CAPTAIN AND DRIVER-ENGINEER POSITIONS BY THREE (3) EACH AND DECREASING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FIRE FIGHTER POSITIONS BY SIX (6); PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite Classification and Pay Plan is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

- A. One additional police lieutenant in the Criminal Investigation Division, effective October 1, 1993.
- B. Increasing the number of fire captain and driver-engineer positions by three (3) each, effective November 1, 1993.
- C. Decreasing the number of authorized fire fighter positions by six (6), effective November 1, 1993.


SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance to be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remain provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present composition of the Police and Fire Departments are inadequate to protect the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite, creates an urgency and emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.


