ORDINANCE NO. 2918

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS
ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF CHARGES FOR VARIOUS
RECREATION SERVICES TO BE EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER
OCTOBER 1, 1993; BY PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY
CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That an ordinance establishing charges for various recreation services to be effective from and after October 1, 1993 be adopted to read as follows:
