## ORDINANCE NO. 2940

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ADOPTION OF ARTICLE III AND SECTION 14-60 THEREBY ESTABLISHING LANDFILL FEES EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 1993; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by adopting Article III and Section 14-60 as follows, in all other respects said Code and Chapter to remain in full force and effect:

## ARTICLE III. LANDFILL

Sec. 14-60. Landfill fees.

(a) The following fees shall be charged effective December 1, 1993 for disposal at the landfill:

SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part or provision so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not Page 3

affect the validity of the remainder of Chapter 14 or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 4. That the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to regulate landfill fees, creates an urgency and emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
