

ORDINANCE NO. 2944

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE SECTION 9-244(a) BY REVISING CERTAIN ROUTES TO THE DESIGNATED TRUCK ROUTES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-244(a) of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

**Sec. 9-244. Same-Designated; signs and markings; designation of alternate routes during repair, etc.**

(a) The following streets and parts of streets are designated "truck routes" under this article.

The following language shall be deleted from Section 9-244(a) of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

<i>Name of Street</i>	<i>Limits</i>
Belt Line Road	Between the north city limits and Interstate Highway 20.
Forney Road	Between Town East Boulevard and the west city limits.
Gross Road	Between Interstate Highway 20 and Military Parkway.
Gus Thomasson Road	Between Town East Boulevard and the north city limits.
Gus Thomasson Road	Between Town East Boulevard and U.S. Highway 80.
Peachtree Road	Between Skyline Drive and Gross Road.
Peachtree Road	Between Skyline Drive and Scylene Road (State Highway 352).

The following language shall be added to Section 9-244(a) of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

<i>Name of Street</i>	<i>Limits</i>
Belt Line Road	Between the north city limit and 400 feet south of Bluffview Drive.
Belt Line Road	Between Tripp Road and U.S. Highway 80.
Forney Avenue	Between Town East Boulevard and the west city limits.
Gross Road	Between U.S. Highway 80 and Military Parkway.
Gus Thomasson Road	Between the north city limit and U.S. Highway 80.
Interstate Highway 20	Between the east and west city limits.
Peachtree Road	Between Gross Road and Scyene Road (State Highway 352).


**SECTION 2.** That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Section 9-244(a) or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

**SECTION 3.** That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.


**SECTION 4.** The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately protect the safety of the inhabitants of the City creates an urgency and emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage and the publication of caption, as the law and in such cases provides.
