

ORDINANCE NO. 2958

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2817 OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, BY ADDING A NEW CATEGORY AIRCRAFT COMPONENT/ACCESSORY RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT AND OVERHAUL, TO THE FIXED BASE AND COMMERCIAL OPERATOR CATEGORIES FOR THE PHIL L. HUDSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That City of Mesquite Ordinance No. 2817 be amended by adding Category P, Aircraft Component/Accessory Research, Development or Overhaul, to the Fixed Base and Commercial Operator Categories of the Rules and Regulations for the Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport to read as follows, in other respects said Rules and Regulations and Ordinance to remain in full force and effect.

CATEGORY P. AIRCRAFT COMPONENT/ACCESSORY RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT OR OVERHAUL

Any Lessee desiring to engage in aircraft component/accessory research, development or overhaul must lease and/or provide as a minimum the following:

I. LAND

Basic Requirement: The Leasehold shall contain sufficient square footage of land for appropriate building.

II. BUILDINGS

Basic Requirement: Construct or lease building providing a minimum of 1,000 contiguous square feet of properly lighted, air conditioned and heated space to house office, restroom facilities and minimum shop and hangar space as required for FAA repair shop certification, if required, and public use telephone.

III. PERSONNEL

Basic Requirement: One FAA certificated repairman qualified in accordance with the terms of the Repair Station Certificate if required.

IV. HOURS OF OPERATION

Basic Requirement: The hours of operation shall be eight hours a day, a minimum of five days a week.

V. INSURANCE COVERAGE


Basic Requirement: \$1,000,000 CSL

SECTION 2. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class C misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for each offense. This section is cumulative of all other penalties for violation of federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and ordinances.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4. The fact that the present Fixed Base and Commercial Operator Categories for the Phil L. Hudson Municipal Airport do not adequately protect the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City, creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.


