ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF NEWSOM ROAD AND A PORTION OF SMOKEY MOUNTAIN TRAIL TO PARKWOOD TRAIL, EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE AND APPROVAL OF THIS ORDINANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION That the name of the section heretofore named Smokey Mountain Trail lying between East Glen Boulevard and Newsom Road, and the section of the street heretofore named Newsom Road lying between Smokey Mountain Trail and Parkwood Trail are hereby changed to Parkwood Trail.

The fact that portions of Smokey Mountain Trail and SECTION 2. Newsom Road affected by the street name change are aligned with the newly constructed Parkwood Trail causes confusion and thereby creates an urgency and emergency for the protection of the public safety and welfare and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
