

## ORDINANCE NO. 2992

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,  
AMENDING THE CITY OF MESQUITE CLASSIFICATION  
AND PAY PLAN; PROVIDING FOR TWO (2)  
ADDITIONAL POLICE OFFICERS AND TWO (2)  
ADDITIONAL FIRE LIEUTENANT POSITIONS;  
PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite Classification and Pay Plan is hereby  
amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

- A. Two additional police officers to become effective January 1, 1995; and
- B. Two additional fire lieutenant positions to become effective January 1, 1995.

SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision  
of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this  
ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. The fact that the present composition of the Police and Fire  
Departments are inadequate to protect the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City  
of Mesquite, creates an urgency and emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become  
effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption  
as the law in such cases provides.


