

ORDINANCE NO. 3034

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 10.9 OF THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND ORDINANCE NO. 1940 ADOPTED OCTOBER 3, 1983; PROVIDING FOR CHANGES TO THE LONGEVITY BENEFIT TO BE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1995 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That Section 10.9 of the General Government Policies and Procedures and Ordinance No. 1940 adopted October 3, 1983 are hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

A. Beginning July 1, 1995, all employees will be paid longevity based on the following scale per month per year of service beginning with such employee's anniversary date:

<u>Number of Years Employed</u>	<u>Longevity Amount</u>
Up to five years	\$4 per month for each year of service
Five through nine years	\$6 per month for each year of service
Ten through fourteen years	\$8 per month for each year of service
Fifteen or more years	\$10 per month for each year of service up to a 25-year maximum

SECTION 2. The fact that the City Council agreed to changes to the longevity benefit creates an urgency and emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.


