NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 2. That the necessity for making and approving of a budget for the fiscal year 1996-97, as required by the laws of the State of Texas, creates an emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as the law in such cases provides.
