AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ABANDONING STREET RIGHTS-OF-WAY FOR FLORENCE STREET FROM GROSS STREET TO DAVIS STREET FOR THE EXPANSION TO MESQUITE HIGH SCHOOL; SITUATED IN DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, AS SHOWN PER THE PLAT OF A. TOSH'S ADDITION TO MESQUITE, AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1, PAGE 292, MAP RECORDS, OF DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND BEING COMPRISED OF A PORTION OF EAST SIDE ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF MESQUITE, AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1, PAGE 309, MAP RECORDS, OF DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Florence Street from Gross Street to Davis Street is not needed for public purposes and it is the public interest of the City of Mesquite to abandon said described street rights-of-way; and the staff recommends the abandonment of the subject street for the expansion to Mesquite High School;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESOUITE. TEXAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the street rights-of-way for Florence Street from Gross Street to Davis Street more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and included herein for all purposes shall be, and the same is hereby abandoned.

SECTION 2. That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires the release and abandonment of street rights-of-way described herein creates an urgency and emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
