

ORDINANCE NO. 3317

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 9-195 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ADDING LANGUAGE THEREBY PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN DESIGNATED STREETS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-195 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

When signs are erected or curbs marked giving notice to such effect, no person shall park or leave standing a vehicle at any time upon the portions of the streets described below:

1. To the list of designated streets in Section 9-195 the following is **added**:

*South Service Road* of U.S. Highway 80, from a point 430 feet east of the east curb line of Town East Boulevard to the west curb line of Presidential Row.

SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance be held to be unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4. That the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately protect the safety of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite creates an urgency and emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
