

ORDINANCE NO. 3330

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REAPPROPRIATING CERTAIN FUNDS FROM THE 1998-99 BUDGET TO THE 1999-00 BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the 1998-99 budget included appropriation of funds for certain large pieces of equipment that are on order but have not yet been delivered; and

WHEREAS, the 1998-99 appropriations for these items will lapse on September 30, 1999; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Mesquite that the 1998-99 appropriations for these items be reappropriated for the 1999-00 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the funding for the following equipment items from the 1998-99 budget be and is hereby reappropriated for the 1999-00 budget of the City of Mesquite:

SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part or provision so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to provide for reappropriation of funds from the 1998-99 budget to the 1999-00 budget creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
