## ORDINANCE NO. 3367

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2918, SECTION 1 BY DELETING THE CURRENT POOL ADMISSIONS IN ITS ENTIRETY AND ADDING A NEW POOL ADMISSIONS TO INCLUDE THE CHARGES FOR THE NEW CITY LAKE AQUATIC CENTER; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2918, Section 1 has been amended to include the admissions for the new City Lake Aquatic Center.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2918, Section 1 is hereby amended by deleting the current Pool Admissions in its entirety and adding a new Pool Admissions to read as follows; said ordinance in all other respects to remain unchanged.
