

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING SECTION 14-74(c) IN ITS ENTIRETY AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 14-74(c) THEREBY AMENDING THE COMPOST RATES; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING MARCH 15, 2002, AS THE DATE SUCH RATE BECOMES EFFECTIVE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by deleting Section 14-74(c) in its entirety and adding a new Section 14-74(c) to read as follows, in all other respects said Code and Chapter to remain in full force and effect.

CHAPTER 14

ARTICLE IV. MUNICIPAL COMPOSTING FACILITY

Sec. 14-74. Use, distribution and sale of processed materials.

(c) Materials produced at the municipal composting facility may be purchased, when available, during normal operating hours as follows:



SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4. That the rate adopted by this ordinance shall be effective from and after March 15, 2002.
