

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING A PORTION OF SECTION 9-10 THEREBY DELETING ANY REFERENCE TO LARCHMONT DRIVE AS A ONE-WAY STREET DURING CERTAIN DESIGNATED HOURS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9, Section 9-10 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects said Code and Chapter to remain in full force and effect.

Sec. 9-10. One-way streets designated.

Amend by deleting the following:


Larchmont Drive, between Rustown Drive and Motley Drive, in a southwesterly direction between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on school days.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite included Larchmont Drive as a one-way street during certain designated hours on school days creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.


