ORDINANCE NO. 3584

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF CARTWRIGHT ROAD TO BEAR DRIVE; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF AUGUST 1, 2003.

WHEREAS, the widening and realignment of Cartwright Road has created a duplication in street name and duplicate street addresses in the 2600 through 2800 blocks of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the duplication of addresses creates confusion for emergency responses, residents and visitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the 2600 through 2800 block segment of the heretofore named Cartwright Road is hereby changed to Bear Drive. The affected roadway segment is further depicted in Exhibit "A."

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That the effective date of the street name change is August 1, 2003.


