AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 150 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY PROVIDING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS AND DELETIONS THEREBY UPDATING AND CHANGING THE EXTENT OF SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CARTWRIGHT ROAD; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the extent of speed limits on certain sections of Cartwright Road need to be updated to reflect recent improvements in roadway geometry; and

WHEREAS, the engineer of record designed Cartwright Road from Pioneer Road to Lawson Road for speeds of up to 50 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9, Section 150 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect.

Sec. 9-150. Same - Designated for certain streets.

A. Amend by deleting the following:

Street	Extent	Speed (mph)
Cartwright Road	From Pioneer Road to Shelduck Drive	35

B. Amend by adding the following:

Street	Extent	Speed (mph)
Cartwright Road	From Pioneer Road to Mesquite Valley Road	40
Cartwright Road	From Mesquite Valley Road to Faithon P. Lucas Sr. Boulevard	45
Cartwright Road	From Faithon P. Lucas Sr. Boulevard to Shelduck Drive	35

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect on and after February 4, 2004.
