

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 150 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE THEREBY LOWERING THE SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN DESIGNATED STREETS IN CREEK CROSSING 11, PHASE 2 SUBDIVISION; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9, Section 150 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect.

Sec. 9-150. Same – Designated for certain streets.

Amend by adding the following:

Bent Brook Drive	From Edwards Church Road to Walden Place	20
Crystal Falls Drive	From Edwards Church Road to Springmont Drive	20
Emerald Oaks Drive	From Helen Lane to Hyacinth Drive	20
Hidden Springs Drive	From Edwards Church Road to Walden Place	20
Hyacinth Drive	From Edwards Church Road to Springmont Drive	20
Springmont Drive	From Bent Brook Drive to Hyacinth Drive	20
Spring Rain Drive	From Edwards Church Road to Springmont Drive	20
Walden Place	From Helen Lane to Bent Brook Drive	20

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect on and after April 21, 2004.


