

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAMES OF AFFI DRIVE TO ASPEN DRIVE AND AFFI COURT TO INDIGO COURT IN PALOS VERDES NO. 11, PHASE THREE SUBDIVISION UPON PASSAGE AND APPROVAL OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the owners of Palos Verdes No. 11, Phase Three subdivision have requested street name changes based upon marketing strategies; and

WHEREAS, Staff reviewed a list of proposed street names and recommend the changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the names of the streets located in Palos Verdes No. 11, Phase Three subdivision heretofore named Affi Drive and Affi Court are hereby changed to Aspen Drive and Indigo Court respectively.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4. That the street name changes are to be effective immediately upon passage and approval of this ordinance creates an urgency and emergency and requires this ordinance take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
