

ORDINANCE NO. 3750

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE CONCERNING THE LOCATIONS OF SCHOOL ZONES BY PROVIDING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS AND DELETIONS TO SECTIONS 9-147(1)(c) AND 9-147(1)(e); PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended by providing certain amendments and deletions to Sections 9-147(1)(c) and 9-147(1)(e) as follows, in all other respects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect:

(a) Amend by deleting the following from Section 9-147(1)(c):

<i>School</i>	<i>Location of school zone</i>
Black/ Agnew	Wilkinson Drive from Corta Drive to Sierra Drive Sierra Drive from Wilkinson Drive to 250 feet east of Lindo Drive

(b) Amend by deleting the following from Section 9-147(1)(e):

<i>School</i>	<i>Location of school zone</i>
Kimbrough	Barnes Bridge Road from 400 feet east of Palos Verdes Drive to 400 feet west of Palos Verdes Drive

(c) Amend by adding the following to Section 9-147(1)(e):

<i>School</i>	<i>Location of school zone</i>
Black/ Agnew	Wilkinson Drive from Corta Drive to Sierra Drive Sierra Drive from Wilkinson Drive to 330 feet east of Lindo Drive
Mesquite Academy	Pioneer Road from 100 feet south of Davis Street to 100 feet north of Cypress Drive


SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.


SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect on and after August 15, 2005.
