AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING SECTION 14-45 IN ITS ENTIRETY AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 14-45 THEREBY AMENDING THE APARTMENT AND COMMERCIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION RATES AND ESTABLISHING DECEMBER 1, 2006, AS THE DATE SUCH RATES BECOME EFFECTIVE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 14 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by deleting Section 14-45 in its entirety and adding a new Section 14-45 to read as follows, in all other respects said Code and Chapter to remain in full force and effect. That the schedule of rates referred to in Section 14-45 (2) is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

### Sec. 14-45. Charges for collection.

- (a) For an apartment residence, the charge shall be \$8.96 per month for each apartment for collection. Provided, however, that the charge for units using a central pickup station shall be \$5.74 per month per unit for twice weekly collection and \$7.66 per month per unit for thrice weekly collection. The foregoing rates are reflected in the chart following Section 14-45(2). Provided further, that units utilizing stationary compactors, serviced a minimum of twice weekly, will be charged the same as the commercial type compactors, as set out in subsection (2) of this section, plus 15 percent.
- (b) For commercial establishments, boarding houses, restaurants and other food establishments, container storage and collection service shall be required and the schedule of rates immediately following and made a part of this section including commercial front-load rates, apartment rates and commercial roll-off rates shall apply.

Provided, however, where container storage and service are inappropriate, residential-type collection may be allowed in which event the charge shall be a minimum of \$26.00 per month for commercial establishments and boarding houses.

With the approval of the City, open top containers are available for certain commercial establishments. The rate charged for these containers shall be \$140.63 per haul charge and a disposal fee of \$18.06 per ton of waste in the container. The charge shall be assessed each time the container is emptied.

With the approval of the City, open top containers are available to contractors and residents doing remodeling and repair work in a residential area. Placement of such container shall be for a maximum period of two weeks annually. The rate

That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part or provision so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid and the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
