## ORDINANCE NO. 3995

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ADOPTING REVISED PAY PLANS FOR CLASSIFIED, FIRE AND POLICE PERSONNEL, AND OTHER CLASSIFIED CITY EMPLOYEES WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF SEPTEMBER 20, 2008; PROVIDING THAT THE CIVIL SERVICE CLASSIFICATIONS AND POSITIONS SET FORTH IN THE 2008-09 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET ARE **HEREBY** ESTABLISHED; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the revised pay plans, more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. That the civil service classifications and positions set forth in the 2008-09 fiscal year budget, be and are hereby established by ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> That the pay plans adopted by this ordinance shall be effective from and after September 20, 2008.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. That the present pay plans of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to provide stability and continuity in the employment of essential employees, creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective as stated in Section 3 above.
