

ORDINANCE NO. 4010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, BY MAKING CERTAIN DELETIONS AND ADDITIONS UNDER SECTION 5-20(C); THEREBY ESTABLISHING SEPARATE PERMIT FEES FOR COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL IRRIGATION INSTALLATIONS; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended by making certain deletions and additions under Section 5-20(c) to read as follows, in all other respects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect:

1. *Section 5-20(c)*. Amend by deleting the plumbing fee under the Residential – Miscellaneous Permits in Section 5-20(c), and adding new plumbing and irrigation fees under the Residential – Miscellaneous Permits in Section 5-20(c) to read as follows:

Residential – Miscellaneous Permits

\$25.00	Plumbing (includes hot water heater replacement)
\$125.00	Irrigation

2. *Section 5-20(c)*. Amend by deleting the irrigation system fee under the Commercial – Miscellaneous Permits in Section 5-20(c) and adding a new irrigation system fee under the Commercial – Miscellaneous Permits in Section 5-20(c) to read as follows:

Commercial – Miscellaneous Permits


\$150.00	Irrigation system
----------	-------------------

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect on and after January 1, 2009.
