ORDINANCE NO. 4013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PROVIDING A TEXAS, BY CERTAIN MESOUITE. 9-195 AND **CERTAIN** DELETION UNDER SECTION ADDITIONS UNDER SECTIONS 9-195 AND 9-199 TO REFLECT PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALONG GROSS STREET W. BETWEEN BRYAN-BELT LINE ROAD AND SOUTH GALLOWAY AVENUE: PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended by making a certain deletion under Section 9-195 and certain additions under Sections 9-195 and 9-199 to read as follows, in all other respects said Code and Chapter to remain in full force and effect:

1. Section 9-195. Amend by deleting the following from Section 9-195:

Street Extent

Gross Street W. Both sides, from South Galloway Avenue to Bryan-Belt Line Road

2. Section 9-195. Amend by adding the following to Section 9-195:

Street Extent

Gross Street W. South side, from South Galloway Avenue to Bryan-Belt Line Road

3. Section 9-199. Amend by adding the following to Section 9-199:

Street Extent Time

Gross Street W. North side, from South Galloway Anytime Avenue to Bryan-Belt Line Road

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provisions of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall become effective on and after January 5, 2009.
