AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ADOPTING PAY PLANS FOR GENERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF OCTOBER 1, 2009, THEREBY PROVIDING ALL ELIGIBLE GENERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES MEETING PERFORMANCE STANDARDS WITH A THREE-PERCENT MERIT INCREASE ON THEIR ANNIVERSARY DATE; ADOPTING REVISED PAY PLANS FOR POLICE AND FIRE PERSONNEL WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JANUARY 1, 2010, THEREBY PROVIDING A THREE-PERCENT MARKET ADJUSTMENT TO ALL RANKS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE PERSONNEL ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE AS WELL AS STEP INCREASES FOR ELIGIBLE POLICE AND FIRE EMPLOYEES ON THEIR ANNIVERSARY DATE; PROVIDING THAT THE CIVIL SERVICE CLASSIFICATIONS AND POSITIONS SET FORTH IN THE 2009-10 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATES THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

- <u>SECTION 1.</u> That the revised pay plans, more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby adopted.
- SECTION 2. That the civil service classifications and positions set forth in the 2009-10 fiscal year budget, be and are hereby established by ordinance.
- SECTION 3. That the General Government pay plans adopted by this ordinance shall be effective from and after October 1, 2009, and the Police and Fire pay plans adopted by this ordinance shall be effective from and after January 1, 2010; and
- SECTION 4. That those General Government employees meeting performance standards will be eligible for a three-percent merit increase at the time of their performance review.
- SECTION. 5. That Police and Fire personnel will receive a three-percent market adjustment to the pay plans for all ranks effective January 1, 2010.
- <u>SECTION 6.</u> That Police Officers and Firefighters who have not reached the maximum salary for their rank will receive step increases on their anniversary date.
- SECTION 7. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. That this ordinance shall become effective as stated in Section 3 above.

Officers at the maximum may only receive higher salaries upon promotion or market-based pay adjustments.

Ranks above Police Officer

Upon promotion, employees are moved to the base salary for the new rank. Future pay increases will be determined by market-based pay adjustment to the base salary.

Market-Based Pay Adjustments
