ORDINANCE NO. 4094

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 9-150 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, BY TEMPORARILY LOWERING THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 60 MILES PER HOUR TO 50 MILES PER HOUR ON A CERTAIN DESIGNATED SECTION OF THE MAIN LANES OF U.S. HIGHWAY 80; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, road construction in the area necessitates that the speed limit on U.S. Highway 80 from Town East Boulevard to Gus Thomasson Road be temporarily lowered from 60 miles per hour to 50 miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9, Section 9-150 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect.

Street	Extent	Speed (mph)
U.S. Highway 80	From west city limits to Town East Boulevard	60 50
U.S. Highway 80	From Town East Boulevard to Gus Thomasson Road	30
U.S. Highway 80	From Gus Thomasson Road to east city limits	60

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.
