## ORDINANCE NO. 4131

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CONCERNING THE LOCATIONS OF SCHOOL ZONES BY PROVIDING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS AND DELETIONS TO SECTION 9-147(1)(a); THEREBY ZONE CONTINUOUS SCHOOL CREATING A WILKINSON DRIVE FOR BLACK ELEMENTARY AND AGNEW MIDDLE SCHOOL; PROVIDING A REPEALER PROVIDING Α SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby amended by providing certain amendments and deletions to Section 9-147(1)(a) as follows, in all other respects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect:

(a) Amend by deleting the following from Section 9-147(1)(a):

School

Location of school zone

Black

Wilkinson Drive from Newsom Road to 475 feet south of Tierra Drive

(b) Amend by adding the following to Section 9-147(1)(a):

School

Location of school zone

Black/

Wilkinson Drive from Newsom Road to Corta Drive

Agnew

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and

upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect on and after March 7, 2011.
