## ORDINANCE NO. 4244

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF THE ORIGINAL MESQUITE VALLEY ROAD TO CREEK CROSSING ROAD; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, changing the name of the portion of the original Mesquite Valley Road between the centerline of Clay Mathis Road and the new Mesquite Valley Road will eliminate confusion by emergency responders and provide for more efficient routing of emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the street numbers will not change with the renaming of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the renaming of the roadway will be effective immediately on and after the passage of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the portion of the original Mesquite Valley Road between the centerline of Clay Mathis Road and the centerline of the new Mesquite Valley Road will be renamed Creek Crossing Road. The affected portion of the roadway is depicted in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That the effective date of the street name change is immediately on and after the passage of this ordinance.
