

ORDINANCE NO. 4685

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 9-150 OF THE MESQUITE CITY CODE, AS AMENDED, BY REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 45 MPH TO 40 MPH ON EAST CARTWRIGHT ROAD FROM MESQUITE VALLEY ROAD TO LAWSON ROAD; BY REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 45 MPH TO 35 MPH ON RODEO CENTER BOULEVARD (FORMERLY HICKORY TREE ROAD) FROM BRUTON ROAD TO SOUTH CURB LINE OF MILITARY PARKWAY; BY REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 45 MPH TO 35 MPH ON LAWSON ROAD FROM INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 20 TO NORTH CITY LIMITS; BY TEMPORARILY REDUCING THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 40 MPH TO 30 MPH ON TOWN EAST BOULEVARD FROM SAMUELL BOULEVARD TO SKYLINE DRIVE DUE TO ROAD CONSTRUCTION; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9, Section 9-150 of the Mesquite City Code, as amended, is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect:

Sec. 9-150. Same – Designated for certain streets.

A. Amend by deleting the following:

<i>Street</i>	<i>Extent</i>	<i>Speed (mph)</i>
East Cartwright Road	From Mesquite Valley Road to Lawson Road	45
Hickory Tree Road	From Bruton Road to south curb line of Military Parkway	45
Lawson Road	From north city limits to Interstate Highway 20	45
Town East Boulevard	From Samuell Boulevard southeasterly to Military Parkway	40

B. Amend by adding the following:

<i>Street</i>	<i>Extent</i>	<i>Speed (mph)</i>
---------------	---------------	------------------------

East Cartwright Road	From Mesquite Valley Road to Lawson Road	40
Rodeo Center Boulevard	From Bruton Road to south curb line of Military Parkway	35
Lawson Road	From Interstate Highway 20 to north city limits	35
Town East Boulevard	From Samuell Boulevard to Skyline Drive	30
Town East Boulevard	From Skyline Drive southeasterly to Military Parkway	40


SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person (as defined in Chapter 1, Section 1-2 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, as amended) violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense, provided, however, if the maximum penalty provided for by this ordinance for an offense is greater than the maximum penalty provided for the same offense under the laws of the State of Texas, the maximum penalty for violation of this ordinance for such offense shall be the maximum penalty provided by the laws of the State of Texas. Each day or portion of a day any violation of this ordinance continues shall constitute a separate offense.


SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after five days after publication.


