

ORDINANCE NO. 4803

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AS AMENDED, BY DELETING AND REPLACING IN ITS ENTIRETY SECTION 9-147(1)(a) AND ADDING A NEW SCHOOL ZONE FOR AGNEW MIDDLE SCHOOL; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$500.00 FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 9 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, as amended, is hereby amended as follows, and in all other aspects said Code, Chapter and Section to remain in full force and effect:

- (1) *Section 9-147(1)(a).* Amend Section 9-147(1)(a) by deleting and replacing Section 9-147(1)(a), the new Section 9-147(1)(a) to read as follows:
 - (a) School zone times for the following elementary / middle school locations are from 7:10 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and from 2:50 p.m. to 3:35 p.m.
- (2) *Section 9-147(1)(a) Table.* Amend the Table under Section 9-147(1)(a) by adding the following the new school zone for Agnew Middle School, to read as follows:

<i>School</i>	<i>Location of school zone</i>
Agnew MS	Paza Drive from Carver Street to Wilkinson Drive

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person (as defined in Chapter 1, Section 1-2 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas, as amended) violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for each offense, provided, however, if the maximum penalty provided for by this ordinance for an offense is greater than the maximum penalty provided for the same offense under the laws of the State of Texas, the maximum penalty for violation of this ordinance for such offense shall be the maximum penalty provided by the laws of the State of Texas. Each day or portion of a day any violation of this ordinance continues shall constitute a separate offense.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after five days after publication.
