- Question 8: Does the City require the use of an truss screed with an invert for alley paving? Or can it all be done by "hand"?
- **Response:** Either method is acceptable
- Question 9: Who is the City project manager and inspector assigned to this project?
- Response: Information will be released upon award
- Question 10: Will the alleys have an integral cub? If so, is there an anticipated linear foot amount?
- Response: There is no integral curb on this project.
- Question 11: Will we be able to work on more than one alley at a time?
- Response: Yes.
- Question 12: Are we expected to install any landscaping not on the plans?
- Response: No.
- Question 13: Are the alleys required to be slip formed or will a vibratory screed be acceptable?
- **Response:** Either method is acceptable.
- Question 14: Is an extra sack of cement required for hand pours?
- Response: No.

Question 15: Will Survey be necessary for this job?

Response: No.

Question 16: Will we be allowed to work on a full alley at a time or are we limited to a certain length?

Response: The sidewalk tie-in quantities are included in the 6" thick concrete pavement quantities
