CITY LAKE PARK 2023-2024 RENOVATIONS BUILDING & SITE IMPROVEMENTS PACKAGE (Bid #2024-019) MESQUITE, TEXAS

The Bidder's particular attention is directed to the following addenda items offered as clarification and in supplement to all previous bid items. (Where changes are made to plan sheets, the changes are clouded and denoted with "delta 1" symbol.) All work shown herein is to be included in the bid for the work:

Plan Sheets

- 1) <u>Sheet A1.0 Doors at Pool Equipment Building:</u> When replacing the new single door into the pump area of the equipment room (located on the east wall of the building), the door shall be furnished with <u>no louvers</u>. When replacing the new double doors into the controls closet (located on the north side of the building), each door shall be furnished with louvers. Refer to notes added to sheet A1.0.
- 2) Sheet A2.0 New Closet on East Side of Building: Please note that the new walls constructed to create a storage closet on the east side of the locker room building have been oriented in the north-south direction to provide a larger closet space. The intent is for the new CMU wall to align with the existing CMU wall on the east side of the last toilet stall in each restroom (as shown on A2.0). Please refer to plan changes on sheet A2.0.
- 3) <u>Sheet A2.0 and A4.0 Baby Changing Station:</u> The baby changing stations for both restrooms will now be furnished and installed by the City of Mesquite and are no longer part of the contract. Please remove equipment and installation of baby-changing stations from the bid.

Bid Form, Specifications and/or General Clarifications

- 4) Railing Clarification: Any notes, specifications, or otherwise in the bid documents indicating the handrails and/or guardrails will be "painted" or "re-painted", the intent is that the new finish will be a powder coat finish.
- 5) Restroom Painting: Both restrooms will be repainted as part of the project. Each restroom will be painted two separate colors. Color #1 will be for the wainscot portion of the walls. Color #2 will be the remaining walls above the wainscot plus the ceilings. All colors will be selected by the City of Mesquite.
- 6) <u>Clarification of Bid Item #A-08:</u> If the City of Mesquite accepts the alternate to replace the vinyl-coated fence fabric, bidders must include in the bid costs for repainting all existing posts and rails prior to installing the new fence fabric.
