

ORDINANCE NO. 107

AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING THE NUMBER OF
INHABITANTS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS
ON SEPT. 7, 1954.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

THAT WHEREAS, Mayor T. O. Williams did on or about August 17, 1954, appoint a committee to conduct a survey of the population within the City Limits of the City of Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of determining a census thereof; said committee consisting of the following:

- (1) Paul Harvey, Manager of Texas Power & Light Co.
(Chairman)
- (2) Joe Tosch, Postmaster, City of Mesquite
- (3) J. F. Richardson, Manager of Lone Star Gas Co.

AND WHEREAS, said Paul Harvey, appeared before the City Council of the City of Mesquite in a regular meeting at the regular meeting place on this 7th day of Sept., 1954, and while under oath did make a full report of the findings of said committee as a result of such survey and census;

AND WHEREAS, it has been determined by said survey and census that the number of inhabitants of the City of Mesquite on Sept. 7, 1954, was 6,021:

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, with a quorum present, in a regular meeting at the Mesquite City Hall hereby approves the survey and census report of Paul Harvey, and hereby finds and determines that on the 7th day of Sept., 1954, the population in the City of Mesquite was 6,021.
