# ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER I, 1954 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1955 AND APPROPRIATING AND SETTING ASIDE THE NECESSARY FUNDS OUT OF THE GENERAL AND OTHER REVENUES OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND FOR THE VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AND IMPROVEMENTS OF THE CITY.

SECTION 1.
