AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF OROINANCE NO. 104 BY EXTENDING THE FIRE LIMITS AND OMITTING AND DELETING SECTION 7, ORDINANCE NO 104

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:
Section 1. Amending Section 3, Ordinance No. 104
The fire limits of the City of Mesquite are hereby extended as

## follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the present fire limits, said point being at the intersection of the extended East line of Walker Street and the North Iine of Texas Street;

- THENCE Soufherly along the East Iine of Walker Street to the Southeast corner of Walker Street and West Main Street;

THENCE Easterly along the South line of West Main Street
to the Southeast corner of West Main Street and Ebrite Street;
THENCE Southerly along the East line of Ebrite Street to the Southeast corner of West Davi's Street and Ebrite Street;

THENCE Easterly along the South I ine of West Davis Street to its intersection with the East line of Rugel Street;

THENCE Southerly along the East iine of Rugel Street a distance of 130 feet for a point;

THENCE Westerly along a line 130 feet South of and parallel to the South line of West Davis to the East line of Locust Street;

THENCE North to the South line of Lot 1, Block 9, Original Town Subdivision;

THENCE Westerly along the South lines of Block 9 and Block 8 , Original Town Subdivision to the West line of Block 8, Original Town Subdivision;

THENCE North to the projection of the South line of Lot I, Block 59, Original Town Subdivision;

THENCE Westerly along the South lines of Lot 1, Block 59, and Lot 1, Block 60, Orisina! Town Subdivision, said lots being the tracts of O. C. McDearman, Jr. and Chaney Miller, respectively, to the projection of the West line of Block 62, Original Town;

THENCE Northerly along the West line of said Block 62 and its projections to the Norih line of the Texas and Pacific Railroad right-of-way;

THENCE Easterly along the North line of the Texas and Pacific , Railroad to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Amending Section 7, Ordinance 104, by deleting and omitting in its entirety the following:
"No permit will be issued for any building or structure used for commercial purposes or as a place of assembly unless the plans or specifications submitted shall have the name of the architect or engineer responsible for the plans plainly indicated and set forth on the face or title sheet of said plans or specifications."
