

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISSOLUTION OF A 10.21 ACRE SUBDIVISION OUT OF THE WILLIAM H. FOREMAN SURVEY, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, KNOWN AS THE SCOTHORN SUBDIVISION, ACCORDING TO THE MAP THEREOF, RECORDED IN THE MAP RECORDS OF DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND ABANDONING THE STREETS AND ALLEYS IN SAID SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, Sam L. Scothorn and wife, Jessie S. Scothorn, have requested the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, to approve the dissolution of a 10.21 acre subdivision in the William H. Foreman Survey, Dallas County, Texas, known as the Scothorn Subdivision, a plat of said 10.21 acre subdivision having been filed for record in the Map Records of Dallas County, Texas; and

WHEREAS the streets and alleys of said subdivision are not being used and have never been used by the public, and

WHEREAS the present platting of the said land is not commensurate with the development of the adjoining property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, that approval of the dissolution of the 10.21 acre subdivision out of the William H. Foreman Survey, known as the Scothorn Subdivision is hereby given, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, that all streets and alleys as shown on the Map of Dedication of the said Subdivision are hereby abandoned by the City of Mesquite, Texas.
