Watts Marks Survey Abstract 937;

ORDINANCE NO. 118

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, FIRMS AND CORPORATIONS TO REMOVE THE DOORS OF ICE BOXES, REFRIGERATORS, COOLING BOXES, ETC. THAT HAVE BEEN ABANDONED OR ARE UNATTENDED; AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION i. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to leave any electric refrigerator, commercial refrigerator, cooling box or ice box unattended in any abandoned house, building, barn or structure of any kind or upon any vacant lot or any other premises in the City of Mesquite where the same may be available to or accessible to children without first removing the doors from such refrigerator or ice box before leaving the same unattended.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$200.00, and each and every act done in violation hereof and each day that such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense and punishable accordingly.
