

ORDINANCE NO. 134AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CERTAIN
TERRITORY OR TRACT OF LAND
IN DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT one certain territory or tract of land situated in Dallas, Texas,
be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Mesquite, Texas, said
territory or tract of land being particularly described by metes and
bounds as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the present City Limits line of the City of
Mesquite, said point also being in the North line of New Market Road
a distance of 175 feet West of the West line of Pioneer Road;


THENCE South 260 feet to the Southeast corner of the Charles
Houser tract;

THENCE West 175 feet along the South line of the Charles Houser
property;


THENCE North 260 feet;

THENCE East 175 feet along the present City Limits to the place of
beginning.
