

ORDINANCE NO. 151

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CERTAIN
TERRITORY OR TRACT OF LAND
IN DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,
AS FOLLOWS:

THAT one certain territory or tract of land situated in Dallas, ^{COUNTY} Texas, be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Mesquite, Texas, said territory or tract of land being particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the present City Limits line, said point being at the intersection of the west line of the W. A. Cole Survey, Abstract 261, and the north line of the Old East Pike;


THENCE westerly at a bearing of north 87 degrees, 54 minutes, 38 seconds west a distance of 645.42 feet;

THENCE north 2 degrees 3 minutes, 57 seconds east a distance of 2352.18 feet to a point in the south line of the new right of way line of U. S. Highway 80;


THENCE easterly along the south right of way line of U. S. Highway 80 to its intersection with the west line of the W. A. Cole Survey, Abstract 261;

THENCE southerly along the present City Limits line, which is also the west line of the W. A. Cole Survey, Abstract 261 a distance of 2214.42 feet to the point of beginning.

PASSED AND APPROVED on first reading April 19, 1955 and second and final reading May 1, 1956.
