## ORDINANCE NO.-172

## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS CERTAIN TERRITORY OR TRACT OF LAND IN DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT one certain territory or tract of land situated in Dallas County, Texas, be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Mesquite, Texas, said territory or tract of land being particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the present City Limits of the City of Mesquite, said point also being at the intersection of the center line of Hanby Drive and the center line of Belt Line Road;

THENCE South along the center line of Belt Line Road to a point in the North right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 80;

THENCE in a Westerly direction along the North right-of-way line of U. S. Highway No. 80 to its intersection with the West line of the S. Caldwell Survey, Abstract 337;

THENCE South along the West line of the S. Caldwell Sur., Ab. 337 to its S.W.corner THENCE East along the South line of the S. Caldwell Survey, Abstracr 337, to its Southeast corner;

THENCE North along the East line of the said S. Caldwell Survey, Abstract 337, to its intersection with the South line of Tripp Road;

THENCE Westerly along the South line of Tripp Road to the East line of the County Belt Line Road;

THENCE South along the East line of Belt Line Road to its intersection with the projection of the center line of Hanby Drive;

THENCE West to the center line of Belt Line Road to the point of beginning.
