ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISSOLUTION OF A 3.25 ACRE SUBDIVISION OUT OF EAST SIDE ADDITION OUT OF J. R. WARRALL SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 1607 KNOWN AS LOTS 1 THROUGH 7, BOTH INCLUSIVE, IN BLOCK 67 AND LOTS 1 THROUGH 3, BOTH INCLUSIVE, IN BLOCK 68, EAST SIDE ADDITION, AND ABANDONING THE STREETS AND ALLEYS IN SAID SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, MITTLE B. REEDY has requested the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, to approve the dissolution of a 3.25 acre tract out of the J. R. Warrall Survey, Abstract No. 1607, Dallas County, Texas, known as Lots 1 through 7, both inclusive, in Block 67 7 and Lots 1 through 3, both inclusive, in Block 68, of East Side Addition to the City of Mesquite, Texas; and

WHEREAS the streets and alleys of said subdivision are not being used and have never been used by the public, and

WHEREAS the present platting of the said land is not commensurate with the development of the property and the adjoining property, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, that approval of the dissolution of the 3.25 acre tract out of the J. R. Warrall Survey, Abstract No. 1607, Dallas County, Texas, known as Lots 1 through 7, both inclusive, in Block 67, and Lots 1 through 3, both inclusive, in Block 68 of a portion of East Side Addition to the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby given, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, that all streets and alleys as shown on the Map or Dedication of the said Subdivision are hereby abandoned by the City of Mesquite, Texas.
