

ORDINANCE NO. 1283

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,
CLOSING A PORTION OF TEXAS STREET BETWEEN
SEATON AND KIMBELL STREETS AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the construction of Belt Line Road has made
the closing of a portion of Texas Street necessary; and


WHEREAS, a public hearing was held in accordance
with law after public notice and notice to the abutting property
owners;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the portion of Texas Street between
Seaton and Kimbell Streets be closed to public use and that
appropriate signs and barricades be erected indicating such
closing.

SECTION 2. The fact that the closing of Texas Street
at this location is required for the safety of the public
creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the
public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordi-
nance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage
and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases
provides.


