

ORDINANCE NO. 1712

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONING OF A 12.5 FOOT PUBLIC STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED SOUTH OF AND PARALLEL TO AN EXISTING 15 FOOT ALLEY ADJACENT TO LOTS 1 THRU 6, BLOCK 7, PALOS VERDES ESTATES NO. 2, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF MESQUITE, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUIT CLAIM DEED TO MURRAY DEVELOPMENT COMPANY; BY PROVIDING THAT SUCH RIGHT-OF-WAY BE ABANDONED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the 12.5 foot public right-of-way described in Exhibit A located south of and parallel to an existing 15 foot alley adjacent to Lots 1 thru 6, Block 7, Palos Verdes Estates No. 2, an addition to the City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, shall be, and the same is hereby abandoned.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby authorized to execute a Quit Claim Deed to Murray Development Company.



That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires that the right-of-way be abandoned, creates an urgency and an emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
