AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ABANDONING THE 15 FOOT UTILITY EASEMENT SITUATED IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS IN THE DANIEL TANNER SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 1462, AND BEING PART OF LOT 3, BLOCK A OF CRAMER ADDITION, PHASE III, AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 86186, PAGE 3748, OF THE DEED RECORDS OF DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUIT CLAIM DEED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite does hereby release, and abandon the utility easement described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That Mayor Brunhilde Nystrom is hereby authorized to execute a quit claim deed to carry out said release and abandonment.

SECTION 3. That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires the release and abandonment of the utility easement described herein, creates an urgency and emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.

THENCE N 88° 03' 00" E a distance of 10.0 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING of said centerline;

THENCE in a northwesterly direction to a point lying in the east line of Gus Thomasson Road, said point being NO1° 31' W a distance of 110.0 feet from the most northerly southwest corner of Lot 3, Block A, Cramer Addition, Phase III.

That The Presbytery of Trinity of the United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America, a corporation, acting herein by and In the United States of America, a corporation, acting natural by and through its duly authorized officers, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1,00) to it in hand paid, the receipt of which is hareby schowledged, does hereby dedicate to the City of Mesquite, the hereinsfeer described tract of land as a public utilities assement, said tract of land lying and being actuated in the City of Mesquite, County of Dallas, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

BRING a 15.0 wide easement. 7.5 ft. on either side of a centerline and being located in a 5.98 acre tract out of the Daniel Tanner Survey, Abstract No. 1462, conveyed to The Presbytery of Trinity of the United Presbyterian Church in the United States of America by J. Dale Edwards, Trustee, and T. C. Stricklin by Ceneral Warranty Deed now of record in Vol. 5364, Page 574, Deed Records, Dallas County, Texas; the centerline of said 15 ft. strip of land being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the most southerly southwest corner of said 5.98 acre tract, said point being on the most easterly R.O.W. line of the Gross Road overpass;

THENCE N. 88 deg. 29 min. E with the south line of said 5.98 acre tract, 10 ft. to the place of beginning of the horeinafter described centarline:

THENCE in a northwesterly direction and crossing the southwest portion of said 5.98 acre tract a distance of approximately 215 ft. to a point on the west line of said 5.98 acre tract, said point being on the east line of the proposed Gus Thomasson Rosd relocation (a 120 ft. R.O.W.); said point being 110 ft. N 1 deg. 31 min W of the most northerly southwest amount of said 5.98 acre tract, said point being the end of the centerline description of the tract begain described.

The hereinabove described tract of land is hereby dedicated as a public utility essement for the perperual use and benefit of the City of utility easement for the perperual use and benefit of the City of Hasquite, providing however, that nothing herein shall be construed as a dedication of said tract as a public street other than for the passage of vehicles owned and operated by the City of Hesquite or its agents. The City of Hasquite shall have the right to remove or keep removed all or parts of buildings, fances, trees, shrubs or other improvements or growths which in any way may endanger or interfere with the construction, maintenance or efficiency of its respective system on this easement; and The City of Hesquite shall at all times have the right of ingress and egress to and from and upon the said easement for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, inspecting, patrolling, maintaining and adding structing, reconstructing, inspecting, patrolling, maintaining and adding to or removing all or part of its respective system without the necessity at any time of procuring permission of anyone.

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
