AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONING OF OUTFALL NO. 2 EASEMENT-EAST IN CREEK CROSSING NO. 2 AND OUTFALL NO. 3 EASEMENT-EAST IN CREEK CROSSING NO. 3; CITY OF MESQUITE, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBITS "A" AND "B" HERETO AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUIT CLAIM DEED; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Outfall No. 2 Easement-East in Creek Crossing No. 2 and the Outfall No. 3 Easement-East, City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, as described in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto, shall be, and the same are hereby abandoned.

SECTION 2. That Mayor Brunhilde Nystrom is hereby authorized to execute a guit claim deed to effect such abandonment to Nash Phillips/Copus.

SECTION 3. The fact that the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires the easements be abandoned creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.





THENCE South 44°51'17" East along said the southeast right-of-way a distance of 1140.20 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING;

THENCE North 15°08'43" East, a distance of 26.44 feet to a point for a corner;

THENCE South 74°51'17" East, a distance of 20.00 feet to a point for a corner;

THENCE South 15°08'43" West, a distance of 37.99 feet to a point for a corner;
