MINUTES OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION MEETING, HELD AT 6:30 P.M., APRIL 13, 2009, 711 NORTH GALLOWAY AVENUE, MESQUITE, TEXAS

I. <u>APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE MARCH 23, 2009, MEETING</u>

II. <u>PLAT</u>

Mr. Armstrong briefed the Commission regarding the plat.
