

RESOLUTION NO. 4-60

DIRECTING THE CITY SECRETARY TO PUBLISH NOTICE TO BIDDERS FOR THE SALE OF FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE NEW CITY HALL AND NOTICE THAT THE CITY COUNCIL INTENDS TO ISSUE TIME WARRANTS; PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF THE NOTICE; AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

1. That the City Secretary of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby authorized and directed to issue a Notice to Bidders in substantially the following form:

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals for the sale of furniture and equipment for the new City Hall will be received by the City Council of the City of Mesquite at the City Hall in said City until 2:30 o'clock, P.M. on March 7, 1960, and opened and read publicly at said time and place.

A list of the items of such furniture and equipment, the specifications thereof, the bidding conditions and other information relating thereto may be obtained from Donald K. Martin, Director of Finance, City Hall, Mesquite, Texas.

It is the intention of the City Council to issue the time warrants of the City for payment of part or all of the contract or contracts to be made pursuant to this notice. Such warrants constitute a part of the issue of warrants, dated October 1, 1959, authorized by ordinance passed on September 4, 1959, pursuant to the notice theretofore published. Said Warrants bear interest at the rate of 5-1/4%. The amount of said Warrants to be issued for the contract or contracts to be made pursuant to this notice shall not exceed \$15,000.00 and shall mature not later than April 1, 1975. The City has obtained a commitment from an investment company for the purchase of said warrants, so that said warrants shall be delivered to the contractor on approved estimates with the stipulation that the contractor will immediately deliver said warrants to said investment company and receive in cash the par value therefor.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities.
