

RESOLUTION NO. 35-61ORDER CALLING AN ELECTION FOR THE ELECTION
OF MAYOR AND SIX COUNCILMEN.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 6th day of February, 1961 the Mayor and City Council of the City of Mesquite passed the following order:

IT IS ORDERED that an election be held in the City of Mesquite on the 4th day of April, 1961 for the purpose of electing a Mayor and six (6) City Councilmen. The polling places for said election shall be Fire Station No. 1 and Fire Station No. 2, and the polls shall be open from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. That polling place No. 1 shall be located at Fire Station No. 1, and that polling place No. 2 shall be located at Fire Station No. 2. All qualified voters residing in County Election Precincts No. 224, No. 230, No. 231 and No. 245 shall vote at polling place No. 1. All qualified voters residing in Election Precincts No. 211, No. 213, No. 237 and No. 241 shall vote at polling place No. 2.

Said election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Texas, the Statutes of the State of Texas, and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Mesquite, and shall be in conformity with the procedures set forth herein.

The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast for Mayor shall be elected Mayor. The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast for Councilman for each Place shall be elected Councilman for that Place for which he is a candidate. In the event any candidate does not receive a majority of the votes cast for a particular office and a run-off election is necessary, said run-off election shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Mesquite.

None but legally qualified voters of the City shall be entitled to vote at said election.


Notice of such election shall be posted in three (3) public places within the limits of the City at least twenty (20) days before the election day. A certified copy of this order shall be attached to said notice and made a part thereof.


A return of such posting shall be made by the affidavit of the City Secretary. L. H. Crane is hereby appointed Presiding Judge of Polling Place No. 1, and Isaac Abernathy is hereby appointed Presiding Election Judge of Polling Place No. 2 to conduct said election and they shall appoint such other judges and clerks as may be necessary to assist them in the holding of said election. All of such judges and clerks shall be

qualified voters in the City. After the holding of the said election, the Election Judges shall promptly make their return to the City Secretary and the Secretary shall thereafter present such returns to the City Council for the canvassing of said election. The Election Judges and clerks may be paid for their services in an amount to be determined by the City Council.
