

RESOLUTION NO. 40-61ORDER CALLING AN ELECTION FOR THE ELECTION OF  
COUNCILMAN, PLACE NO. 4 AND COUNCILMAN, PLACE NO. 6.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 4th day of April, 1961, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, passed the following order:

WHEREAS, at the regular municipal election heretofore held on the 4th day of April, 1961, no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the following offices, to-wit:

Councilman, Place No. 4  
Councilman, Place No. 6

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that an election be held in the City of Mesquite on the 18th day of April, 1961, for the purpose of electing Councilman, Place No. 4 and Councilman, Place No. 6, in accordance with Article IV, Section 5 of the Charter of the City of Mesquite and the provisions contained therein for run-off elections. The polling places for said election shall be Fire Station No. 1 and Fire Station No. 2, and the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 P.M. That Polling Place No. 1 shall be located at Fire Station No. 1, and that Polling Place No. 2 shall be located at Fire Station No. 2. All qualified voters residing in County Election Precinct No. 224, No. 230, No. 231, and No. 245, shall vote at Polling Place No. 1. All qualified voters residing in County Election Precincts Nos. 211, No. 213, No. 237, and No. 241 shall vote at Polling Place No. 2.

Said election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Texas, the Statutes of the State of Texas, and the Charter Ordinances of the City of Mesquite, and shall be in substantial conformity with procedures set forth herein.

The candidates receiving a majority of the votes cast shall be elected to the office for place for which he is a candidate.

None but legally qualified voters of the City shall be entitled to vote at said election.

Notice of such election shall be posted in three (3) public places within the limits of the City at least ten (10) days before the election day. A certified copy of this order shall be attached to said notices and made a part thereof.


A return of such postings shall be made by the affidavit of the City Secretary.

Mr. L. H. Crane is hereby appointed Presiding Election Judge of Polling Place No. 1, and Mr. Isaac Abernathy is hereby appointed Presiding Election Judge of Polling Place No. 2 to conduct said election, and they shall appoint such other Judges and Clerks as may be necessary to assist them in holding said election. All of such Judges and Clerks shall be qualified voters of the City of Mesquite. After the holding of the said election, the Election Judges shall promptly make their return to the City Secretary, and the Secretary shall thereafter present such returns to the City Council for the canvassing of said election. The Election Judges and Clerks may be paid for their services in an amount to be determined by the City Council.
