RESOLUTION NO. 60-61

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS

WHEREAS, by resolution heretofore passed by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, all of those portions of the following highways and streets shall be improved by paving, to-wit: Gus Thomasson Road from U.S. Highway 67 to the intersection of Gus Thomasson Road and Karla Drive; Cates Drive from the alley west of Oleander Trail to the alley east of Modlin Street; and,

WHEREAS, by the terms of said resolution, specifications were ordered to be made by the Director of Public Works for the improvement of said highways and streets as provided by said resolution; and.

WHEREAS, said specifications have been prepared and are now submitted to the City Council for approval and adoption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the specifications so presented to the City Council of the City of Mesquite by the Director of Public Works and prepared by him for the improvement of said highways and streets enumerated above, as hereinbefore defined, have been carefully considered by the City Council, and the same are hereby approved and adopted as to the specifications for the improvements of the said highways and streets.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance be, and he is hereby instructed to advertise for sealed bids for the construction of the improvements called for by this resolution, such advertisements for bids to be published in the Texas Mesquiter, the official publication of the City of Mesquite, which is a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Mesquite. The advertisements shall run one time each week for two weeks, and the bids shall be received not earlier than 14 days from the date of the first publication. All bids shall be received subject to the terms and provisions of the Charter of the City of Mesquite and shall be filed with the Director of Finance on the date and hours specified, and shall be opened and read publicly.

SECTION 3. The City Council, in initiating this proceeding, is acting under the terms and provisions of the act passed at the First Called Session of the Fortieth Legislature of the State of Texas, known as Chapter 106 of the Acts of said Session, together with any amendments thereto, now shown as Article 1105b of Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, which said law is an alternative method for the construction of street and highway improvements in the City of Mesquite, Texas, and which has been adopted and made a part of the Charter of said City, being Section 12, Article III of said Chapter.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
